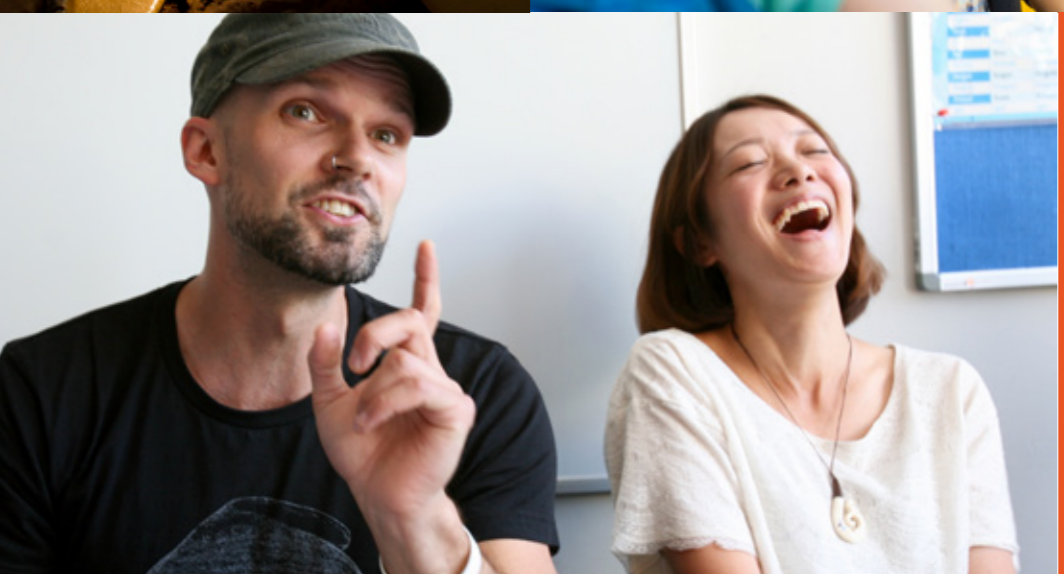

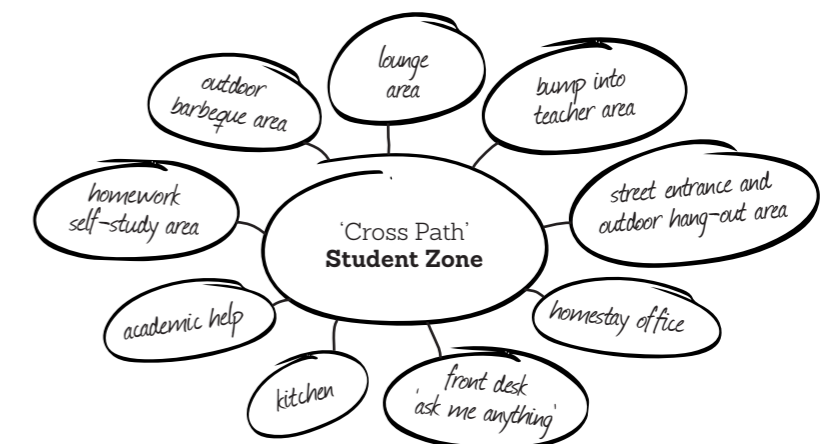
Our Student Zone

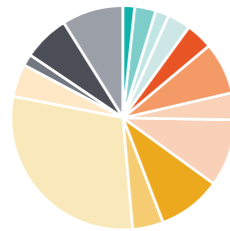
Academic Care

- Graduation certificate and report showing strengths, weaknesses and level achieved, in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

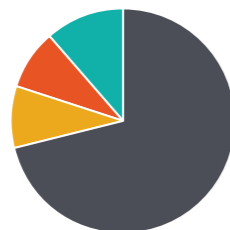
What you can expect

Connect with Nature

Close to Nelson

There is a wide choice of beautiful places to explore close to Nelson. Swim in the clear water of Cable Bay, just a 20-minute drive from Nelson. Go wine tasting in the many vineyards near Nelson. Have a barbecue and swim at Rabbit Island – there is even a cycle path from Nelson. About an hour's drive away you can hire a kayak at popular Kaiteriteri Beach, with its golden sands.

One to two and a half hour's drive from Nelson

Do a day or multi-day coastal walk in stunning Abel Tasman National Park. Or kayak it. Run down the sand dunes to the spectacular rock formations of Wharariki Beach, just west of Cape Farewell. If you love the mountains, climb Mount Robert or walk around Lake Rotoiti in Nelson Lakes National Park. Look for hobbits in Kahurangi National Park, one of the locations in the Lord of the Rings films. It's wild and it's bold. You might even meet a cheeky kea, New Zealand's alpine parrot! It's only found in the South Island.

Explore the rest of the South Island when you finish your study

Nelson is a key gateway for travel around the South Island. Most students do a loop around the island and come back to visit. All ex-students are welcome to use the wifi in our student zone. There's no time limit on this welcome – even after 20 years or more!

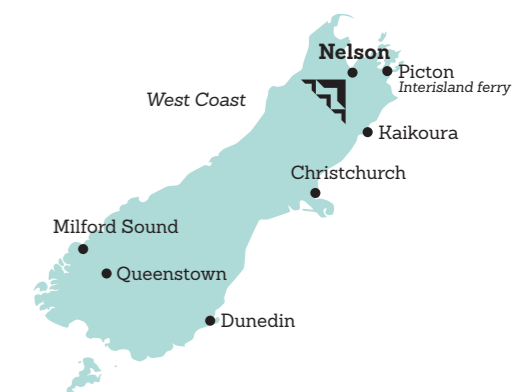

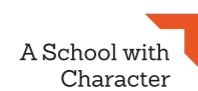
