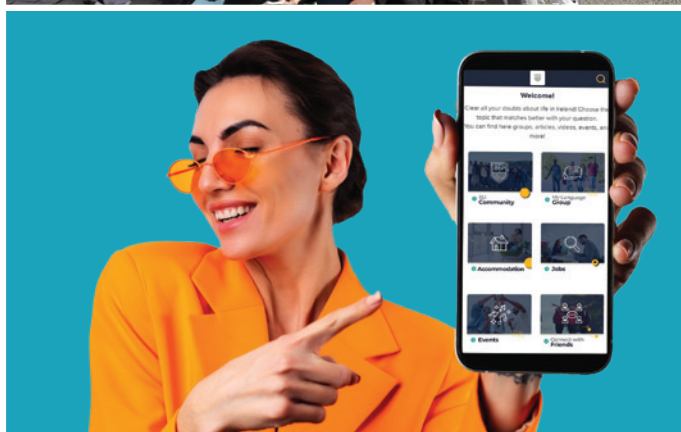

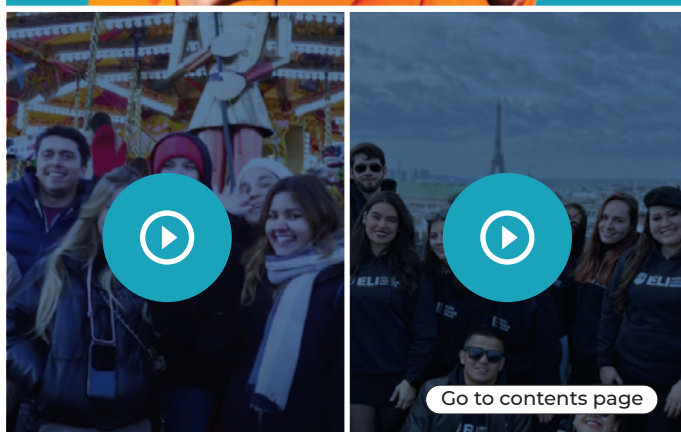

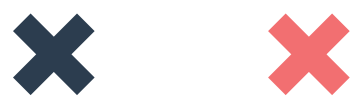

Our Programs

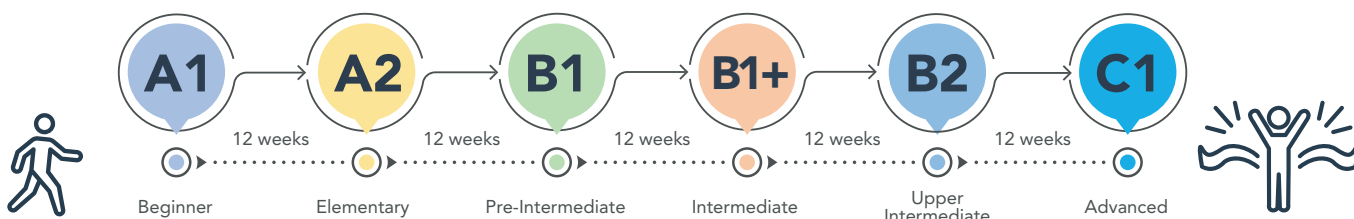
Our core program is General English 15 hour which focuses on the four main skills (writing, reading, speaking, and listening) while developing each student’s individual grammar and vocabulary. Students can upgrade to a 20-hour program with a choice of Speaking Fluency, Business or Academic English. Our curriculum and teaching methodology has been designed to match the highest international standards, yet we personalise our approach so we can meet the needs of every individual learner.

Teaching Methodology

Using a communicative approach our lessons are taught using a task- based method involving topics and themes from everyday life. We use a central course book for each level and teachers supplement these using authentic materials including newspapers, magazines, and a suitable use of technology.

Strong Curriculum

Our curriculum is carefully planned and mapped to the Common European Framework ensuring a global standard. Our curriculum includes a progress test every 6 weeks and a progression test every 12, with a class test every week to ensure you understand and know where you are at every step.



General English – 15 Hours

Our General English 15-hour course is a core program that focuses on the four main skills while developing each student's individual grammar and vocabulary.



Reading

Expand your range of reading sources with graded readers, magazines, and newspapers



Writing

Improve your grammar skills while practising formal and informal writing in emails, reports, letters, and essays.



Speaking

Develop your speaking fluency with level specific conversations, role play, debates, and presentations



Listening

Enhance your listening skills with level specific radio extracts, podcasts, and online video.

General English – 20 Hour Program

Our General English 20 Hour Program is for goal-focused students who want to advance in English over a shorter timeframe. Building on General English 15 Hours, these programs include 5 hours of skill-focused and level specific elective lessons which students can select according to their ambitions. Each level and subject have a 12-week curriculum divided in 6-week units where it is intended students would attend for a minimum of 6 weeks.



Speaking Fluency

Levels A1 - B1

Speaking Fluency is designed to improve a candidate's speaking fluency and accuracy is delivered as a level specific structured conversation class using a range of formats including role play, debates, and oral presentations.



Professional English

Levels B1 - C1

Professional English is designed for students who want to improve formal professional English for use in all work-related scenarios including emails, presentations, and negotiations. It is ideal for candidates who want to advance their careers and professional opportunities.



Academic English

Levels B2 - C1

Academic English is designed to develop the academic skills students will need to study at an English-speaking university or college. The skills covered include referencing/paraphrasing, critical thinking/textual analysis, and academic word list/nominalisation.

Accommodation

We offer all our students the option to choose the type of short-stay accommodation that best suits their requirements. We offer a choice of single, shared in host family with meals included, or single or shared in student residences. For our Short Course Flexi Program we've included a shared room only, with the flexibility you might be placed in host family or an ELI student residence. We'll ask for your preferences at the time of booking, and will propose the best option that suits your age, gender and nationality at the time of arrival. Host families include breakfast and dinner but require an average 45-minute commute to the city and school. Residences are self-catering but are within a 30-minute walk of the city and school.

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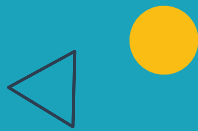
